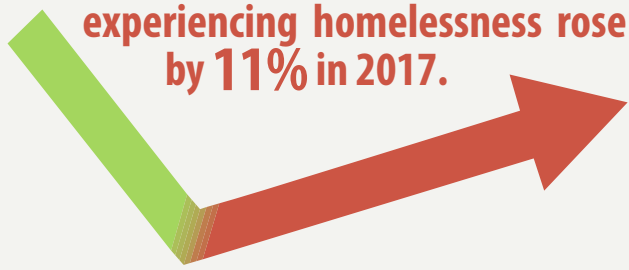


# THE 2017 STATE OF HOMELESSNESS IN NEW HAMPSHIRE

From the NH Coalition to End Homelessness

After decreasing by **19%** from 2015 to 2016, the overall number of people experiencing homelessness rose by **11%** in 2017.



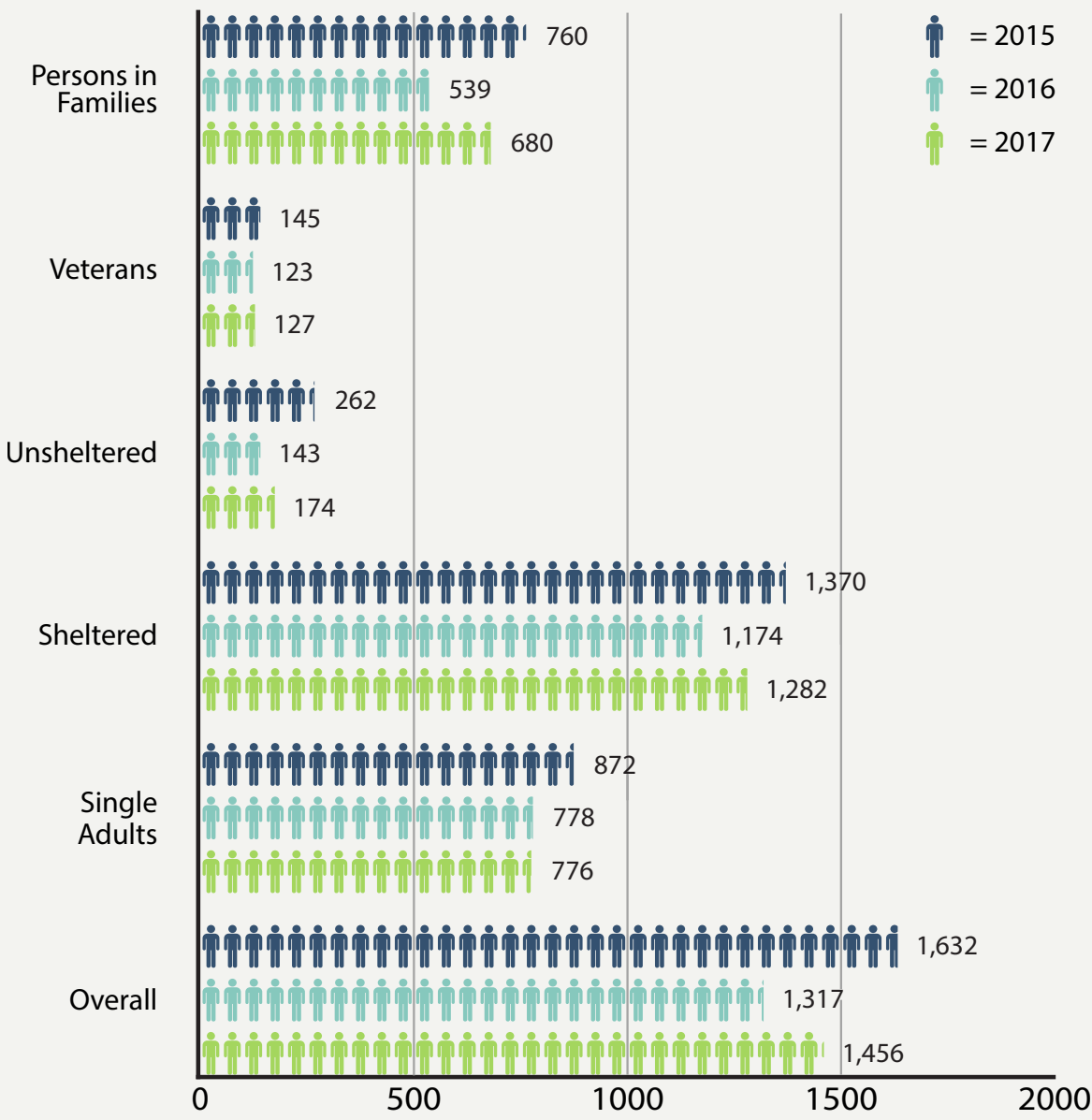
NH median household renter income increased **3.3%** from 2015-2017. Median gross rent (2 bedroom) increased **8.8%**.



**FOR RENT**

The vacancy rate in NH is down **36%** from 2015.

Veteran Homelessness is down **12%** from 2015 with a slight increase in the past year.



After dropping by **29%** last year, the number of people in families with children experiencing homelessness rose by **26%**.

The number of students experiencing homelessness rose by about **6%** in the last year.
